The original and each copy of an application for a passport must have attached to it a copy of the applicant's photograph. A loose signed photograph of the applicant must accompany the application. The photographs must be on thin paper, should have a light background, and be not over three inches in size.

This blank must be completely filled out. The legal fee of one dollar, in currency or postal money order, and the applicant's certificate of naturalization must accompany the application. The rules should be carefully read before mailing the application to the Department of State, Division of Passport Control, Washington, D. C.

I, Ignatius Mueller, a NATURALIZED AND LOYAL CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, hereby apply to the Department of State, at Washington, for a passport.

I solemnly swear that I was born at Baden, Germany on February 1st, 1864; that my father, Vaselinus Mueller, was born in Germany and is now residing at (dead); that I emigrated to the United States, sailing from Haver, France about May, 1880; that I resided 40 years, uninterruptedly, in the United States, from 1880 to 1920 at Belville and Chicago, Ill; that I was naturalized as a citizen of the United States before the County Court of St. Clair at Belleville, Ill on Oct. 28, 1888, as shown by the Certificate of Naturalization presented herewith; that I am the IDENTICAL PERSON described in said Certificate; that I have resided outside the United States since my naturalization at the following places for the following periods:

and that I am domiciled in the United States, my permanent residence being at Chicago in the State of Illinois, where I follow the occupation of carriage-maker.
