- 1964 Saint Louis City Directory has a listing for George Trenkler and a Mary Trenkler that is a widow thought to be George's mother Margarita.
- Accounted for all passengers listed on the Empire City with exception of Gabriel and daughter Catharine .

0 Option 1 and 2 assumes that either Gabriel's brothers or older sons and went ahead of the family to find their new home in Saint Louis, MO. For this to be his sons, they would have had at least a 10 year span between these two that went ahead and the three that was with them.
