

## **George Emmet Trinkler**



**Born in Saint Louis, MO Apr 30, 1867**

**Died : Dec 07, 1946**

**Father: Charles Trinkler**

**Mother: Henrika Lumonstom**

**Married Irene Mary Hercules April 20, 1892**

### **Records in hand**

- **George death notice in Saint Louis, MO Dec. 07, 1946**
- **Have a photo of George working for The Paper Box Company and a monthly Company book titled RE-SAW dated in the 1920s.**
- **1916 their son, Charles Lester Trinkler dies from injuries while playing in railroad cars. He died the day before his 12<sup>th</sup> birthday.**
- **They go on to have 14 children of which 4 died as infants.**
- **George marries Irene Hercules April 20, 1892.**
- **George does not show up on any 1900 census, he would have been 23 and his mother has died and his father is remarried. Sisters Rosa and Kate are living with Catherine Trinkler in 1900 and their father Charles is not listed.**
- **George's mother, Fredericka Trinkler dies on August 13, 1887 at 3203 n 6<sup>th</sup> street Saint Louis, MO**

- **No record but if you go by the census George's father remarried to Catherine Uhrich about 1884.**
- **No record of a divorce of George's parents Fredericka and Charles however, there is a record of a birth of Kate Trinkler May 9, 1884 to George (believe to be an Uncle to Charles and who they lived with in 1880) and Fredericka. Assumption is that Charles and Fredericka got a divorce.**
- **June 1880 census, Charles Trinkler, lived on 3203 2<sup>nd</sup> Street Saint Louis, Mo. Listed are Charles wife Henrika 31 years old, Charles/Henrika's Children, George age 13, Christine age 8, Rosine age 6 and Louisa age 1.**
- **Missouri State birth certificate April 30, 1867.**
