- **1910 census list Johanna and Jacob with five children.**
- **1880 Census list Johanna with husband Jacob age 29, Julia Bleitner age 9 (listed as her sister and she would be the youngest of Henry and Cristine Bleitner's children), Johan E. Schmitter age 6 (would assume this to be the son of Jacob with a prior marriage). Johanna's mother Cristine cannot be found.**
- **Johanna marries Jacob May 22, 1879.**
- **1870 census for Cristine (Trenkler) Bleitner age 26, living in Saint Louis, MO her family of: Henry Bleitner age 42, Hanna Bleitner age 10, Kate Bleitner age 8. Jenny Bleitner age 4 and Rosa Bleitner age 2 and Rosine Schmidt age 64. This appears to me the same family, Rosina age 64 is the mother of Christine/Catharina.**
- **1860 census has the name Catharina Bleitner age 20, living in Saint Louis, MO her family of : Henry Bleitner age 28, Johanna Bleitner age 0, and Rosina Bleitner age 52. This appears to me the same family, Rosina age 52 is the mother of Christine/Catharina.**
